- ✓ **2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development: Food (access to food, its status as determinant of health etc..) continues to be preeminent in Development Goals**
- ✓ **Reaffirmed that Food Safety and Food Security are inter-related**
- ✓ **More advocacy may be needed to ensure that Food Security, but also Food Safety remain at the top of agendas for investment(s)**
